MINERALS RESEARCH CONFERENCE

A 1 or 2 day conference on minerals research in UK universities will be held in London in December 2009. The conference, which is organized by IMMA, the International Mining and Minerals Association, is designed primarily to provide an opportunity for post-graduate students to make short presentations on their thesis research topics to an audience of their peers and representatives from the minerals industry. Its objectives are to help students hone their presentational skills and to interact with other minerals research groups, as well as to publicise themselves and their work to potential employers.

The scope of the conference will be broad, covering all aspects of minerals production, including applied earth science, mining technology, mineral processing, extractive metallurgy and environmental protection. In addition to student presentations, keynote lectures will be given by invited experts. Registration fees and other costs will be kept as low as possible, depending on sponsorship.
